2. What role has a certain activity (sports, orchestra, band, theater, etc.) played in your life?
3. Tell us about your future goals and career plans.
4. Provide a description of your current status if you come from a disadvantaged economic background, have to overcome significant obstacles in life, or someone who is the first person in your family to go to college.

C. High school transcript (Can be unofficial or official).

D. Provide two letters of recommendation, relatives excluded, to explain why you should be considered a scholarship recipient. Examples: Teacher, Professional, Church Youth Group Leader, Community Leader, etc. Enclose the recommendation letters with your application. **Please do not include a photo or resume with your application.**

Fueling The Future Scholarship Criteria

1. The recipient's primary residence must be in the Greater Atlanta area, Georgia.
2. The recipient must be a high school senior.
3. Must be a permanent resident or citizen of the United States.
4. Preference will be given to women preparing for a career in the energy industry (for example, electric power utilities, oil or natural gas), and preference will be given to STEM students.
5. The recipient must have a cumulative grade point average of at least a 3.0 (calculated on a 4.0 scale) in school.
6. The scholarship may be used at any two-year or four-year accredited college or university.
7. A combination of academic ability, leadership qualities, and community involvement will be used in determining the scholarship fund winners.
8. Preference will be given to students with a disadvantaged economic background or someone who overcame significant obstacles in her life, or someone who is the first person in her family to go to college.
9. WEN of Greater Atlanta's Board of Directors will oversee and administer the scholarship funding.
10. Scholarship winners must notify the Coordinator of the program (WEN of Greater Atlanta) of the college they will be attending. Winners who have not notified the Coordinator by June 30, 2023 will forfeit the scholarship.
11. Scholarship finalists will be invited to and must attend a formal interview process.
12. Scholarship applicants will receive an email notice or phone call that their application was received.
13. WEN of Greater Atlanta Directors, employees and their family members are not eligible to receive this scholarship.
